Irene Bell OAM

Irene Bell, who was born in 1906 and died in 1995, was a member of the International Women's Day Committee for more than 35 years, 30 of which she was the Honorary Secretary.

She and Flo Edmonds and others reformed the IWD Committee and organised IWD celebrations that helped raise the status of women in the community.

Irene fought tirelessly for the unemployed, personally helping many of them with no thought for her own welfare.

She campaigned for women's right to choose and was a great supporter of women taking their place in Parliament and local government.

Irene was a longstanding officer with the Port Adelaide Group of the Union of Australian Women and took part in the 1931 "Beef March" at Port Adelaide in which the unemployed protested at being expected to eat mutton or have their children go hungry.

The award will be presented at the annual South Australian International Women's Day Luncheon Friday 6 March 2020 at the Adelaide Convention Centre.
